

WELCOME TO CAMP AURORA – YOU’RE REGISTERED!

Junior, Intermediate & Teen Camp

We’re excited that you’re joining us for a week of camp! Please read this through carefully so you’re prepared and ready to enjoy all that Camp Aurora has to offer.



Please remember to eat a good supper before you arrive for camp. Besides a snack on Sunday night, breakfast on Monday will be the first meal provided. A reminder that drop off and registration is between 6 – 7 p.m. on Sunday.



Canteen money should be brought if you did not pay for this with your registration. Please hand this in to the Camp Dean when checking-in your child at camp. Remember...maximum of \$15.00 per week.



Any medication you are bringing should be brought in a resealable plastic bag with the camper’s name on it. If it is prescription, the dispensing instructions must be included and be in their original packaging. Over the counter medications should also be included. All medications (Tylenol, Benadryl, etc.) MUST be handed in upon check-in. Campers with epi-pens should bring 2 to camp (one to be kept on them, and one to keep in our medication cabinet) due to the distance from the hospital.



Camp Aurora is an electronic-free zone. This means no cell phones, tablets, iPods, etc. If your parents would like to speak with you or you would like to call them, the camp phone is available. Parents, please use 767-2420. If campers do bring electronics, they will be stored in a locked cabinet until pickup on Friday.



What you should pack to ensure your stay with us is enjoyable:

- Sleeping bag or blanket
- Twin fitted sheet
- Pillow
- Weather appropriate clothing - be prepared for hot and cold, rain and shine
- Running shoes and hat
- Bathing suit & towel (no bikinis, or covered with a t-shirt/tank top)
- Bug repellent and sunscreen
- 6 clothes pins
- Bible, note paper and pen
- Toiletries
- Camera – remember phones are not allowed
- Cards, books or other items to use during quiet time



Who will be caring for your child?

We have a great staff consisting of a Camp Dean, Senior & Junior Counselors, Cook, Certified Lifeguard, Maintenance Personnel and, of course, a Pastor! Among our staff are experienced young adults, experienced teens and teens-in-training who are volunteering their time to make your child's week at camp the best it can be.



First time at Camp Aurora? Here's how to find us...we're a 31 km drive from County Fair Plaza, so give yourself enough time.

- Take Dawson Road/Hwy 102 to Dog Lake Road
- Follow Dog Lake Road for 21 km
- Once you pass both West and East Surprise Lake, turn right on Howcum Lake Road
- Follow Howcum Lake Road for 3.5 km
- Turn right on Warnica Lake East (you'll pass Warnica Lake West first)
- We're the first driveway on the right – you've arrived!



Pick up time at the end of camp starts at 5:00 p.m. and ends at 6:00 p.m. Please make arrangements to pick your child up on time - they miss you and our staff need time to rest and get ready for next week's camp!
